The Wyoming Migration Initiative has been working with WYGISC over the past few years to design and build a data viewer for ungulate GPS data. The migration viewer hosts data for GPS ungulate studies in Wyoming and acts as long-term archive and viewer for people to explore and learn about the studies that have been done and the animal movements from these studies. All of the location points from study animals can be animated and viewed. Agency personnel have access to additional tools and functionality not available to the general public.
